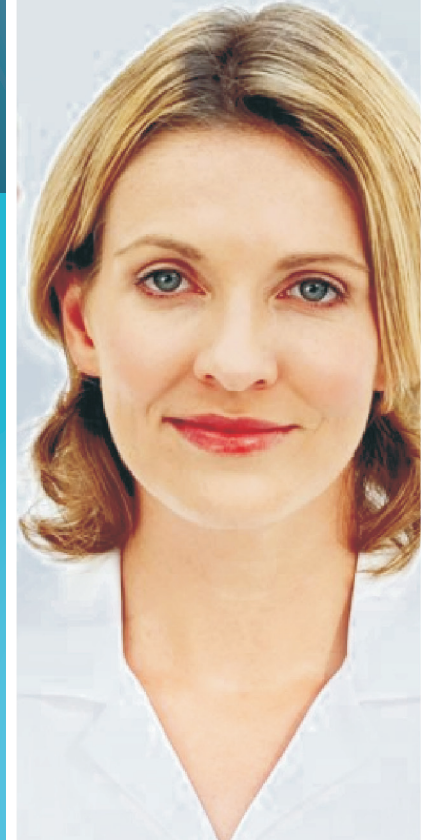
### Objectives

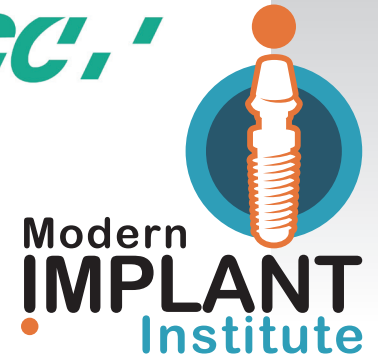


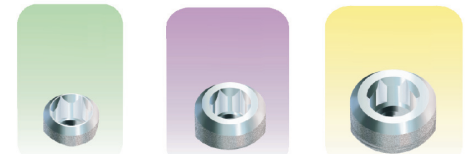

# Learn the procedure...Practice the techniques...Place your own implants!

## Day 1 - Prosthetic

Successful implant dentistry begins with the end in mind. On the first day, you will learn the basic guidelines for a predictable outcome. We will focus on the two types of restorations that every dentist should be providing in their practices, the two implant overdenture and the single unit posterior implant restoration. Live patient procedures will help you visualize the techniques you will be practicing on our course specific training models.

The didactic elements will concentrate on case selection, treatment planning and problem solving, and a review of the important anatomical landmarks.

## Day 2 - Surgical

You will learn the surgical concepts necessary to place your own implants. We will reinforce this with live patient surgeries that will help you visualize the procedure intraoperatively. Then, you will practice the techniques you've seen and learned on models and pig jaws. We will cover implant placement, suturing techniques, minor grafting, and problem solving.

The didactic portion will include surgical instrumentation, anxiolysis, the protocol for placing your own implants at the Modern Implant Institute, and basic marketing principles to begin cultivating your implant practice.
